

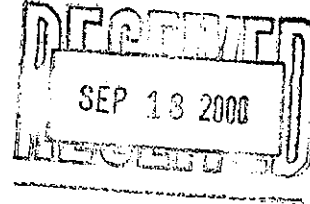

RE: Rocklin High School Fence

As a follow up to our meeting on Wednesday the 13th, the Rocklin Unified School District is in agreement with your organization in regards to the need for a 6 foot tall black iron fence between our two properties and will pay for one-half of the cost. In addition, your organization will redirect the water that is currently flowing from your property on to ours, and repair the damage that has occurred on our property due to the water.

I will be meeting with the Rocklin High School principal and will discuss possible steps that may be taken by the high school to discourage students from entering or leaving the high school site via your property and I will ask the principal to notify all students and parents that the fence will be installed and that access through this area will be denied.

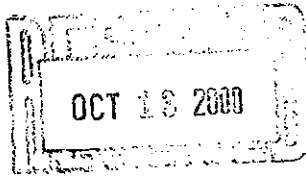

RE: Rocklin High School Fence

Concerning your question as to whether or not the Rocklin Unified School District would support or desire a gate in the fence to be located between our two properties, the answer is no. I have discussed the matter with appropriate district and site administrators, and we are all in agreement that a gate would render the fence useless.

Our concerns are and have been safety of the students. First of all, we do not have personnel to monitor that portion of the campus during the times when students would be arriving and leaving. Second, there is no available campus monitor to insure that students are not leaving the campus when they should be in class. And finally, and possibly most important, with a gate there would be no way that we could control who was entering the campus. Due to safety concerns, this would not be acceptable.
